



Nature-walking in Estonia (5 Days)



Holidays in The Baltic's from 7475 EEK/ 479 EUR

A 5- day walking tour starts from Tallinn, through picturesque Lahemaa National park to South of Estonia. Walking in Estonia is a wonderful experience, especially out of the major cities: forests and nature, romantic countryside with giant stork nests.

You get overviews about Estonian wildlife history and nature.

We will walk on countryside nature trails- forests and bogs. Generally flat, well maintained. It is the perfect rural setting for walking. Overnights are spent in one of many homely hotels or guesthouses.

Itinerary	
Day 1	Transfer from Tallinn to Lahemaa National Park , 3,5 km walk in Viru Bog Nature trail, picnic. Transfer to Altja Fishermen's village, 8-10 km walk in Altja and Oandu. The ancient Altja fishermen's village offers a glimpse into the life of coastal people in olden times and its genuine romantic aura is a real treat for an appreciative traveller. Near Altja you can walk along the wonderfully refreshing Oandu forest trail, which with its numerous information boards also offers an educational experience. Among other things, you will find traces of elk, bear and wild boar, springs with crystal-clear water, windfalls, as well as dunes formed by the ancient sea: thousands of years ago waves of the Baltic Sea washed the shores here. Transfer to Sagadi manor complex, possible to visit RMK Sagadi Forest Museum. Dinner in Sagadi manor restaurant. Accommodation in Sagadi Manor Hotel.
Day 2	Breakfast in hotel. Transfer from Sagadi to Aegviidu, 10-12 km walk towards Jäneda . Lunch picnic. Jäneda Manor houses a unique musical observatory of the composer Urmas Sisask. Popular eating and partying places in Jäneda are Musta Täku Tall and the seafood restaurant Suur-vanker that is built on a huge horse carriage. Dinner in <i>Musta Täku Tall</i> (Stable of Black Stallion) in Jäneda. Accommodation in Jäneda guesthouse. Possible to visit Jäneda manor, handicraft centre, evening party in Stable of Black Stallion.
Day 3	Breakfast in Jäneda. Transfer from Jäneda along Old Tallinn-Tartu Road to Endla Nature Reserve . Bog walking 4 hours, lunch picnic. Bogs are one of the oldest landscapes in Estonia. Their development started after the ice-age ended 11000 years ago. Bog walk starts with regular hike on the woods. When approaching higher bog areas we clip on snowshoes we took with us. Using snowshoes we can environmentally and easily visit damper and softer parts of the bogs. In the afternoon transfer to Tartu- City of Good Thoughts. Mentioned for the first time in 1030, Tartu is the centre of South Estonia and the country's second-largest town. Its pride is the University of Tartu, founded in 1632. Guided orientation walk (City tour- Old Town, Toome Hill...). Dinner in restaurant. Accommodation in centrally located hotel.
Day 4	Breakfast in hotel. Free time in Tartu Transfer from Tartu to Otepää . Otepää Nature Park is a highly appreciated holiday area comprising a landscape of rolling hills and lakes, romantic winding village roads and small rivers. Otepää also boasts the most beautiful lake in Estonia – Pühajärv (Holy Lake), featuring in many artists' paintings. Lunch picnic. Walking in Otepää Nature park, about 12 km Dinner in Pühajärve Spa Accommodation in Pühajärve Spa Hotel, in the coast of lake Pühajärv.
Day 5	Breakfast in hotel. Transfer to Taevaskoja -Kiidjärve nature protection area . The primeval valley of the Ahja River lays Taevaskoda with its 24-metres high bare sandstone rocks that are 400 million years old. Walking on the bank of Ahja river, Kiidjärve-Valgesoo mill-Kiidjärve, 20 km; lunch picnic. Evening transfer back to Tallinn. <i>Possible to book accommodation from City Bike, is not included to the price.</i>
